

# Celebrating "Life is Sweet" with Dr. Alveda King

## **BANQUET RAISES RECORD FUNDRAISING TOTAL OF \$210,682**

On Thursday, April 20, 2022, Ashland Pregnancy Care Center (APCC) held the 16th Annual Fundraising Banquet featuring Dr. Alveda King as the special quest speaker. Those in attendance numbered over 660 people who celebrated protecting life "from the womb to the tomb." Being a fundraising banquet, the event resulted in over \$210,682 in one-time gifts and pledges supporting the life affirming-work of APCC.

The evening included a powerful discussion with Dr. King, client testimonies, and exciting announcements about APCC. It was an utter joy to host Dr. King and to hear her thoughts on current day issues including

pro-life endeavors, the Critical Race Theory, and Christianity. A key highlight from the discussion was her perspective on power. While referencing her uncle the late Dr. Martin Luther King Jr, she said, "No black power, no white power, only God power and human power working together." She also shared her experience with the civil rights movement and her opposition to Critical Race Theory. She

claimed, "During the civil rights movement, many of the leaders were pastors, and they marched for what was called civil rights. Race at that time was based on skin color, but you know there's only one human race- Acts 17:26 of one blood."

Throughout the evening, she continued to highlight the importance of all human life, irrespective of skin color or age. Dr. King also spoke on post abortive mothers and the need to "educate and say there's two patients- a mama and a baby. They're both people." After the discussion, Dr. King led the audience in her rendition of "This Little Light of Mine" and

Along with the expanded client services, Melanie also announced the purchase of the new ultrasound machine, a \$40,000 investment. Seeing the ultrasound images is often the turning point for clients to choose life. From the Sanctity of Human Life Sunday and special church offerings, donors committed \$24,663 in gifts and pledges towards the ultrasound machine, Samaritan Hospital Foundation matched the SOHL offering with a \$20,000

gift, raising the total to \$44,663! It is now installed and working beautifully at APCC to serve clients and show them the SWEET life of their little ones. Thank you for valuing each and every life.

# A Message from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,
What does it look
like to trust God in
the midst of change?
June 24, 2022 is an
Ebenezer moment.
In the Old Testament
we see Samuel
describe this clearly
as he takes time to
remind the people of
God's faithfulness.

1 Samuel 7:12... Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen and called its name Ebenezer for he said, "Till now the Lord has helped us."

Samuel didn't do this so the people would remember God's intervening for a few hours or a couple of days. No, this Ebenezer was to be a reminder for generations to come that God hears and answers prayers.

This is how I feel about the June 24, 2022 Supreme Court decision. This is our moment to raise an Ebenezer for generations to know that God heard and answered our prayers. Roe's overturning is a beautiful reminder of the importance of consistent and faithful prayers. I know that so many of you have done that for us. You have prayed at your home, in your small group, in our counseling rooms, in our parking lot. Your prayers were heard and answered, and the love and support has been overwhelming.

There will be time for discussion and strategy for post-Roe era but today we celebrate! Will you celebrate with us? You can do that with us as we raise our Ebenezer. Your gift today will let generations know that thy are loved and cared for.

We have longed for this decision, and we are grateful to God for our part in it. I pray we never forget the work that has led to this day. Help us by making sure this moment is celebrated for generations to come. Thank you for making APCC a reality for 41 years.

# WHAT NOW? Our work is not done!

Ohio's Law: The Heartbeat law went into effect on 6/22, which says once a heartbeat is detected the baby is protected (as early as 6 weeks). In May, I had the privilege to give testimony in favor of The Human Life Protection Act (which would prohibit abortion in our state). Each state now has the power to decide—so join me in continued prayer for Ohio.

Protection of Pregnancy Centers: Many pregnancy centers are experiencing protestors and facilities are being vandalized and destroyed across the country. Help us by securing our center with a security system, window protection, and other safety measures to ensure our team and clients are safe and protected.

**Reaching Her:** Help us update our website and online presence to reach the woman seeking a chemical (medication) abortion. The window to reach her is getting shorter.


# Volunteer of the Year Award


# APCC Expanding Services

## Labon & Delivery Classes

## **NEW this past February**

excited to teach the labor and delivery classes at the Ashland Pregnancy Care Center. Equipping women and men for one of the most memorable events in their lives is a rewarding experience.

Evidence-based research indicates childbirth education reduces maternal anxiety, decreases preventable maternal and infant death, improves birth satisfaction, and empowers women and men to engage in their own healthcare choices. We are excited to add a 1 hour, 3-week labor and delivery class to the education offered through the pregnancy center. The first class focuses on the basic anatomy and physiology of labor, early signs of labor, false versus true labor, and the stages of labor. The second class presents options for pain management during childbirth, including pharmacological and non-pharmacological. During this interactive class, mothers will practice breathing techniques and positioning on birthing balls. The third class includes information and expectations during the postpartum period. There are opportunities for clients to interact, discuss concerns, and ask questions during every class.

IMPACT: While in the Labor and Delivery Class, one of our clients remarked, "Why aren't there more people here? This is great! More people need to be here."
